ELIGIBILITY & ADMISSION CRITERIA

Min. Eligibility: 10+2 or Equivalent with a minimum of 60% marks (CBSE, ISC, State Boards, IB, Cambridge, and other Government Recognized Boards) and NIFT/NID/NATA/UCEED/JEE-2/CEPT score

For Admission into B.Des. program: Applicants are selected through a holistic admissions process conducted over three rounds based on a personal statement, supplemental application, X and XII Grade Marks, Faculty Interview etc. The following minimum scores are required to receive an invitation for Personal Interview & Portfolio Review. Results required – JSAT-50 %/SAT-1100 & above/JEE-2-165 Marks & Above/NATA- 80 Marks & Above / NIFT-Qualified/NID-Qualified/UCEED PART A (Total) – 50 and above.
